The 2005 Corvette'N America Tour in Flagstaff from Jun 2-5 had a good turn out & was considered a success. Many Corvettes from for 13 states were there, with even one from Florida. There were 5 SW Chapter NCRS members & their cars on the Tour. Most of the tour group stayed at the beautiful Little America hotel. We were all in the same area, & the hotel blocked off special parking for the Vettes, which



included a wash facility. On Friday, Jun 3 we gathered at a local super market parking lot early in the AM, & then went by caravan to the Grand Canyon. There were miles of Corvettes, with police assistance at the departure points. I am told that we were on TV that night.

Upon returning to Flagstaff we then gathered at the Museum 66 Club for drinks & entertainment. On Saturday AM there was a "Show & Shine" show at a local high school. Saturday afternoon, after the show, we went to Arizona Snowbowl & took the chair lift up to the top for the ride & fantastic view of Northern Arizona (up to about 11,500 feet with snow & a bit cold). Upon returning back down we gathered at the closing banquet. Prizes were given out, but the most impressive was a \$4525/4 day Bondurant School of Racing training class won by Cheryl Nance (wife of Jack). They were there with 6 other members of the Southern Arizona Corvette club of Tucson, & won the \$500 for the most Corvettes of any club there (NCRS had only 5, but as Jack is a member of both, we can feel good).
